*“There are two main things that I have been trying to focus on. The first one is to plan my lessons as if they were lessons in the children’s first language and then estimate at which point they would need help understanding so that later I can think of simple ways of providing that support. The second one is*

*introducing more creative teaching techniques like singing, drawing, watching videos related to human rights, role plays, group work, etc. so that through fun activities children can learn new things while at the same time enjoying the process.”*

*“The activities outside work range from playing carrom and watching Indian movies in the evenings to visiting a local family during their Puja celebration and going on a weekend trip to Chennai and Mamallapuram”*


